Annual Report for the Academic Year 2020-21

The academic year started on 1st September 2020 and ended on 19th August 2021. During this academic year, there has been a phenomenal increase in student intake.

The total admissions for the year were 1039 for all UG and PG programmes together.

The academic year commenced with an Orientation Programme, held on 7th September 2020; and classes started immediately thereafter.

In addition to curricular transactions, there were co-curricular, extra-curricular, sports and games activities. The various Cells, Forums and Committees organized programmes throughout the academic year.

The Internal Quality Assurance Cell initiated and carried through all the programmes. The IQAC was in the forefront of initiating every quality enhancing and sustaining activities in the institution. Besides, the IQAC has been streamlining the documentation of all college activities, positioning itself as the catalyst in our mission to enhance and sustain academic, administrative and research quality.

AQAR was prepared and submitted to the NAAC on time by the IQAC. Across the academic year, Continuous Internal Assessment of students' academic achievements took pride of place, and as a result, the Summative Semester End Exams (SEE) saw our students in top gear and fully prepared.
