Application forms may be obtained from the Directorate of Correspondence Course & Distance Education, Bangalore University, in case of Directorate of Correspondence Course students and old repeaters students from their respective colleges by paying Rs. 21/- the duly filled applications should be submitted to the Directorate including study Centers in case of Directorate of Correspondence Course students and affiliated colleges students of their respective colleges appearing under One Time Measure Students.



The candidates are advised to fill in all the relevant columns in the examination application form correctly, failing which the applications are liable to be rejected and they are also advised to preserve the acknowledgement portion of the application forms. Particulars of the previous attempt, subjects passed with Register numbers and year of passing and subject/s should invariably be entered in the application and copies of marks cards must be enclosed. Examination application forms should be submitted to the Directorate Correspondence course and Distance Education by the students on the last date stipulated for payment of Examination Fee through Online. The Directorate of Correspondence Courses and Distance Education is requested to record a certificate at the end of each candidates list as follows:

The names of the candidates included in the lists have been approved by the University and only the candidates who are eligible to take the examinations as per the University Regulations are included in the list".

The Directorate of Correspondence Courses and Distance Education is requested to send the applications along with prescribed perform so as to reach BA/B.Com/BBM Preparatory sections concerned on or before **04.01.2021** by MUDDAM. failing which Rs. 5,000/- will be imposed as penalty for late submission.

The Directorate of Correspondence Courses and Distance Education is requested to collect the examination fee from the students/study centers and remit the same to the University Funds by **ONLINE PAYMENT** on or before **29.12.2020 (without Fine) & 04.01.2021 (With Fine)** as the case may be and the fee collection statement has to be sent by the Directorate of Correspondence Courses and Distance Education together with the applications duly scrutinized. It is the responsibility of the Directorate of Correspondence Courses and Distance Education to ensure that examination fees prescribed is collected and remitted to Bangalore University Funds promptly. The financial statement in quadruplicate with necessary certificates thereon may be sent directly to the Finance Officer, Bangalore University, Bangalore, with a copy to the Registrar (Eva).

As per resolution of the Academic meeting held on **03.09.2020** The students who have completed their course and could not complete their degree are permitted to appear for I,II&III Year BA/BA (Music) B.Com/BBM/BBA/B.Sc. (FAD)/B.Sc./BASLP/BHM & BVA I,II,III & IV year examinations of **February-2021** as One Time Measure subject to condition that, they shall study and pass the examination as per the existing syllabus only.
