Faculty members apprise Heads of Departments about the status of syllabus coverage.</p> <p>In the unlikely event of any faculty member lagging behind, (s)he engages extra sessions. Allout efforts are made to ensure that syllabus is not only completed, but revised and evaluated as well. Principal elicits reports from all heads of Departments, and ensures that there is no failure of syllabus completion, besides collecting feedback about it from students. The excellent results in summative evaluation bears out the fact that syllabus completion is ensured.</p>
